



PROVISIONAL EMPLOYEE STATEMENT

I, _____ hereby swear and/or affirm that:

- (1) I will apply for the information required for Act 114 (Federal Bureau of Investigation – FBI) and will provide a copy of the appropriate completed request forms to the employer;
(2) Nothing found in the results will disqualify me from employment pursuant to Act 114;
(3) I understand that PA-Educator is permitting me to have a complete file on a provisional basis pending receipt of the above clearance and any inaccurate, false or incorrect statements shall be grounds for immediate removal from the database.

Section 4302 (relating to incest)
Section 4303 (relating to concealing death of child)
Section 4304 (relating to endangering welfare of children)
Section 4305 (relating to dealing in infant children)
A felony offense under section 5902(b) (relating to prostitution and related offenses)
Section 5903(c) or (d) (relating to obscene and other sexual materials and performances)
Section 6301 (relating to corruption of minors)
Section 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children)

(b) An offense designated as a felony under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L. 233, No. 64), known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act."

(c) An out-of-state or Federal offense similar in nature to those crimes listed in clauses (5) (a) and (5) (b).
